We are a small privately owned holiday complex of 4 properties situated on the Bideford Bay Holiday Park in beautiful North Devon. Some are on a wooded hillside with panoramic views across the ever changing seascape of Bideford Bay, the distant headlands of Hartland, Croyde and further afield the coastline of Wales. We are situated above the little fishing village of Bucks Mills and are only 3 miles away from the picturesque cobbled village of Clovelly. You are only a short distance from the rugged cliffs and shipwrecks of Hartland with its spectacular waves on stormy days or the pleasant sandy beaches of North Devon and North Cornwall. The Southwest Coastal Footpath runs through the park and so links Barnstaple and Bude. There is plenty to do for all the family on site or visit the surrounding gardens, beaches, activity parks, golf clubs, etc. Whether you want to walk, cycle, golf, horse ride, paint, practice your photography or just chill out and admire the peace and quiet of the park, we hope you will leave us revived and relaxed. **PETS WELCOME** in selected chalets.

Each chalet comes complete with bathroom and kitchen welcome packs, beds made up, freeview, DVD/CD player, TV, fridge, microwave and full size cooker and free electric. There are heated indoor and outdoor swimming pools and numerous activities, for all to enjoy. Books and games are also supplied in the chalets as well as guides to many of the surrounding attractions.

Only about 1 ½ hours from your chalet you can find the hidden biomes of the Eden Project which is the biggest attraction Cornwall has to offer and well worth a visit. If you are a bit more adventurous you can surf first at Westward Ho! North Devon, then try the waves at the famous Fistral beach at Newquay, North Cornwall, only 56 miles away. Are you a fan of 'Doc Martin'? Why not visit the picturesque village of Port Isaac, near Newquay, which is where it was filmed.

DIRECTIONS

From the M5 or A303 at Junction 27, join the A361 and head for Barnstaple. On the outskirts of Barnstaple join the A39 and head for Bideford and Bude. After crossing the Torridge Bridge you reach a roundabout. GO ACROSS the roundabout thus bypassing Bideford. Head for Clovelly and Bude. Still on the A39, go through Fairy Cross, Horns Cross and on to Bucks Cross. Just past the sign on your left for Bucks Cross, you will see on the right a red telephone box. DO NOT turn down to the right but continue on about 20 yards to the Bideford Bay Holiday Park sign on the right and turn in there. Phone from there, please.

The Chalets

The chalets have a cosy atmosphere about them and we have had numerous praises (see visitors book in the chalets). Dogs welcome by arrangement, Sea Valley 50 is dog friendly.

Three of the Chalets have showers, and one chalet has a bath and shower. All chalets are double glazed and have heating in bedrooms, lounge and bathrooms. There is a selection of games and books in each chalet and guides to surrounding amusements and places of interest. Beds will be made up on arrival.

Sea Valley 49, 50 & 51.....with panoramic sea views.

These three chalets are situated above the Manor house area. There is a good view of the children's play area from the lounge windows and beautiful panoramic views across the bay to Wales on a clear day. These chalets have single showers in the shower rooms and heating in the shower rooms, bedrooms & lounge.



Each chalet has a complete kitchen with microwave and fridge etc. All bedding and electricity is supplied. There is a sheltered sitting out area between chalets 49 & 50. These chalets sleep up to 6 using foam mattress beds and **INCLUDING** infants. **Sea Valley 50 is dog friendly. MAX OF 2 dogs.**

Bay View Villas 51

This chalet is situated further up the holiday park away from the amenities and would suit people who want a quieter area to stay in. This chalet has a pine ceiling in the lounge, heating in bedrooms, bathroom and lounge. Bayview sleeps up to 4 including infant.



There is a south facing patio at the back and a veranda at the front which looks out over the bay and the cliffs. This chalet also has a bath with an 'over the bath' shower and separate toilet. All bedding and electricity supplied. There is a small complete kitchen with fridge and microwave etc.



North Devon and Beyond...

North Devon boasts some of the most beautiful and wild landscapes to be found in the South West. And Sea Valley Holiday Chalets, is located right in the heart of this amazing and dramatic landscape.

North Cornwall and North Devon has managed to create a delicate balance between heritage and history and the modern lifestyle its visitors want. This can be seen by visiting "[Barnstaple](#)", a bustling



market town at the end of "[Exmoor](#)" and the beginning of the "[Braunton Burrows](#)", an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB).

To the west, you a stone throw from "[Tintagel and Boscastle](#)". Then its the beautiful surfing paradise of Bude and its golden beaches and fantastic waves. Keep going and you get to Newquay and Padstow renowned for its amazing Cornish Restaurants serving local delicacies.

Go south for the day and you hit "[Dartmoor](#)". Full of fantastic and challenging walks, National Trust castles, Churches and the odd Dartmoor Pony. Then your ready for the shops! Plymouth is one of the most beautiful and historical cities in the country. The shopping centre has been rebuilt completely since the war and has every shop you can think of. Park the car and take a walk to The Hoe or just head down to the Barbican and enjoy a Captain Jaspers Burger... legendary in those parts.

Exeter is just up the A381, and is another fantastic day out in South Devon. More shops than you can count and many, many cafes and street bistros. The stunning Exeter Cathedral dominates the skyline and is a must for any history buff as is the narrow 16th century lanes and peculiar shops.

Half way down the A38, swing a right to Torbay and Totnes. Towns totally dedicated to the "art of enjoyment" and relaxing. Torbay, encompasses Torquay and Paignton, stunning old fashioned holiday resorts from yesteryear. There is even still a pier! Totnes has the most beautiful riverside pubs and the high street compels the visitor to stroll and wander through nick nack shops and bizarre.

Heading North from Sea Valley and your looking towards rugged coastlines and the Atlantic Highway. Cliff top views looking out towards Lundy and its famous Puffin colony. Turn right and your



right on top of "[Clovelly](#)" and the stunning cobbled lanes descending at impossible inclines towards the harbour. If your a fan of this then a must would be a visit to Lynton and Lynmouth as well and then along to Porlock and its infamous hill!

Bideford, "[Great Torrington](#)" and Braunton are places that are a must to drop by. Or if you're an activity enthusiast, visit many of our local bike hire centres and enjoy the Tarka Trail, miles and miles of cycle path passing through idyllic scenery and skirting hidden beaches. These paths are great for the jogger and there are many running clubs that dont mind the odd visitor to flat foot the lanes and paths of North Devon and Cornwall.



Fore! Yes you've guessed it, so many golf clubs dot our glorious countryside. From the absolute pro to the beginner, there is a club to suit. Is that to strenuous for you? Then there's lots of good food to be had and more importantly good pubs. Hidden pubs, famous pubs, pubs by rivers, pubs on cliffs and the good old village pub with its characters.

Mingle with the rich and famous! Well not quite but North Devon and Cornwall is steeped with legend of celebrity old and new. Did you know, Phil Vickery MBE the rugby player was born in Barnstaple? Peter Sellers first stepped on to a stage in sunny "[Ilfracombe](#)" and Joan and Jackie Collins both went to a school in North Devon whilst evacuated from the Blitz.

A little older, Sir Francis Chichester was born in Barnstaple, Charles Kingsley, author of The Water babies was born and raised in Bideford. Later he published the novel "Westward Ho!". This book was the inspiration behind naming the village of Westward Ho! which incidentally is the only place in the UK which contain an ! in its name. And finally Henry Williamson who moved to Georgeham near "[Croyde](#)" in 1921 and published "Tarka the Otter".

So whether its walking, rambling, swimming, hiking, "[surfing](#)", relaxing, snoring, eating, chilling, exploring or just sat reading the newspaper, Sea Valley Holiday Chalets is your perfect starting and finishing point.
